Where is everything?

In Magnolia Park Sports and Social Club

Registration

Packs of registration numbers will be given to your team manager (teacher or other nominated person).

Please do not allocate unused numbers to late entries: any changes should be notified to the registration desk so that a unique number can be issued: otherwise athletes will receive the wrong results.

When should I arrive?

You should aim to be at the course an hour before the race starts to allow for collecting numbers from your team manager and warming up. Do arrive in plenty of time as you may need to park away from the course.

Parking

Police patrol the A4128 White Hill / Valley Road and no parking is allowed anywhere along this road or on the verges.

It may take you some time to find a car parking space. Please allow plenty of time, be patient and be considerate of local residents and other users of the park and roads.

Cars

There is no parking for cars at Magnolia Park.

Coates Lane - Parking is available on the roads on and around Coates Lane at the back of the back of the park. Please do not block the gates to the park which may be needed for ambulance access.

St Michael and All Angels Church - There are a small number of spaces at St Michael and All Angels Church at the north end of the park, accessed via the entrance to Hughenden Manor. The course is a ten minute walk across the fields.

Hughenden Manor - The National Trust have kindly offered the free use of some spaces in their car park at Hughenden Manor. Please do not park on the access roads.

As you enter, stop and tell the kiosk attendants that you are attending the cross country.

You must walk to the course (approx. 15 mins) via the Manor and not down the access road: take the path out of the corner of the car park towards the Manor and you will be directed from the kiosk. Please show your appreciation of the National Trust's support by donating in the marshal's bucket.

NT members are asked to show their membership cards at the kiosk to help with central funding.

Disabled and Minibuses

Parking for the disabled and for school minibuses is available at Magnolia Park.

Medals

Medals will be awarded for the top 3 placed girl and boy athletes in each age group at the finish line.

The top three in the team for the winning school in each age group will receive a gold medal.
