The 2017 cross country races will be held on **Saturday 7th October** in Hughenden Park.

Your support has helped to make this one of the largest school cross country events in the country. The race programme and entry system will be the same as for recent years' races.

Race programme

The race programme's nine races cover the top two years of junior school and all senior school age groups. Once again, there will be separate races for Year 5 and for Year 6 athletes.

A full timetable for the event will be posted on the Wycombe Phoenix Harriers website in early September.

The entry form and provisional race details are available now on the club's website in the "News" and "Events" sections. The website address is www.wycombephoenix.org. Schools wishing to enter athletes will need to download the entry form, complete it electronically in Excel and email it back to the Wycombe Phoenix Harriers e-mail address included on the entry form.

As we are expecting a high number of entries, a close date of Friday 29th September will be imposed. Entries will be free but school entries for Year 5 & 6 races will not be accepted on race day.

We will issue an event reminder email to schools in early September at the same time as publishing the final timetable.
