2	Club Members / Parents etc	2	Evening of Friday 4 th Jan	Load up the equipment at Little Marlow Track
3	Club Members / Parents etc	2	Sometime around. 4pm – 5pm on Sat 5 th Jan	Unload equipment at Little Marlow Track
4	Club Members / Parents etc	8	9am to 11.30am on Sat 5 th Jan	Set up the marquee, course etc at Hughenden
5	Experienced with cross country events	1	10am to approx. 3.15pm on Sat 5 th Jan	Clerk of the course – walking the course at Hughenden and trouble-shooting throughout the competition
6	Club Members / Parents etc (must be over 16)	Equivalent of 10 throughout the day	10.45am to 3.15pm (approx. two hour slots might be possible) Sat 5 th Jan	Marshal the course at Hughenden
7	Club Members / Parents etc (must be over 16)	Equivalent of 4 throughout the day	10am to 1pm (approx. 1 hour slots might be possible) Sat 5 th Jan	Show competitors the way from the Hughenden Avenue car park and keep an eye on the parking situation in the residential roads / reporting any problems. Will require quite a bit of walking.
8	Club Members / Parents etc	8	3pm – 4pm pm Sat 5 th Jan	Take down the marquee, course etc at Hughenden
9	Club Members / Parents	Equivalent of 2 throughout the day	2 hour slots from 11am to approx. 2.30pm Sat 5 th Jan	Selling sweets / soft drinks (proceeds to Club) at Hughenden
